3. Has made an outstanding contribution to the Phoenix Chapter #58 to enable the Chapter to better meet its chapter management goals of:
  - a. Understand and respond to the needs of our market and, specifically, the management requirements of our target market.
  - b. Provide a means for our membership to meet their goals and objectives by adding value to their individual skills, talents, knowledge, and abilities.
  - c. Develop responsive delivery systems in programs, education, and all Chapter activities which reflect the Total Quality Management (TQM)/ Total Customer Satisfaction (TCS) philosophy necessary to add value to everything we do.
  - d. Create and maintain a Chapter management structure to support and attain the Chapter vision and mission as reflected in annual achievement of Passport Gold/Platinum status.
